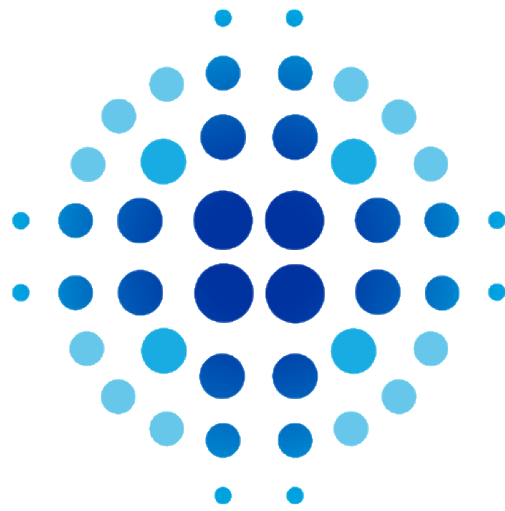

We've designed a small activity booklet for kids to do during the live streaming sermon time to help them join in and focus in a meaningful way.

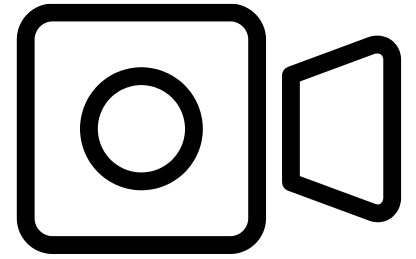
You might not be able to print things off at home, so if that's you, some of the pages you'll be able to do in a notebook, blank paper or as a word doc.

Things you'll need this week:

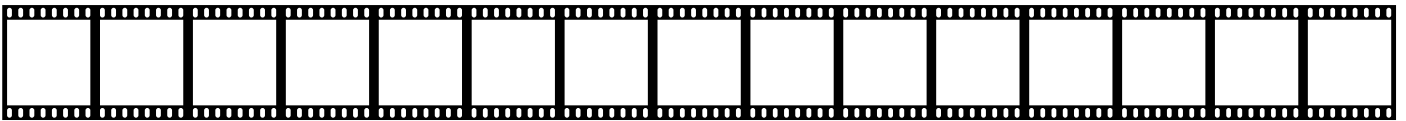
- Printed handouts (choose which pages) OR blank notebook with screen to look at OR device.

We'll be sending out extra resources on Monday for you to keep the conversation and learning time going for your kids this week.

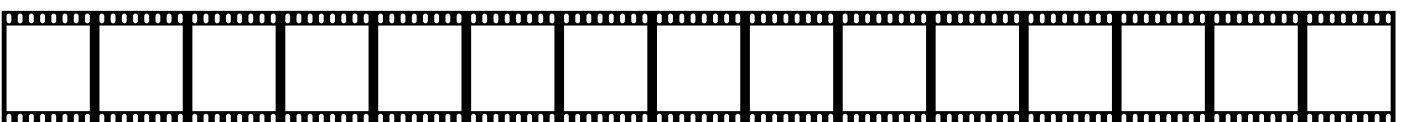
# RECORD

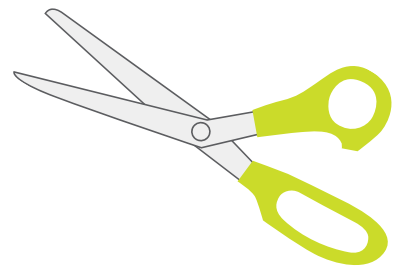

# MAKE



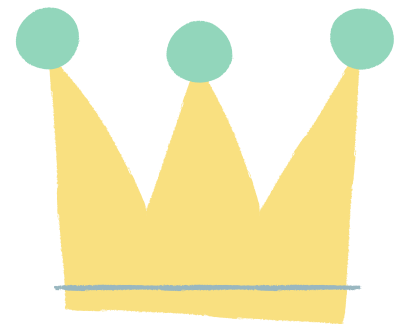
**Read** John 4:13-14 & John 7:37-39.

# DESIGN



**Read** John 4:25-26. Jesus says he is the Messiah, the King God promised would rule his kingdom forever!

Option 1: Design your own crown to help you remember Jesus is the King!

- Measure your head - Use paper or cardboard to wrap around your head.
- Cut out your crown design (triangles along one side) & decorate!
- Stick the paper together with tape or glue.

Option 2: Design a crown placemat

- Get a blank A4 piece of paper. Draw an outline of a crown.
- Write the bible verse (John 4:25-26) on it or the words 'Jesus is the King'.
- Decorate
- If you have a laminator at home, laminate the finished placemat
- Use it to put your plate on at dinner time! ☺
