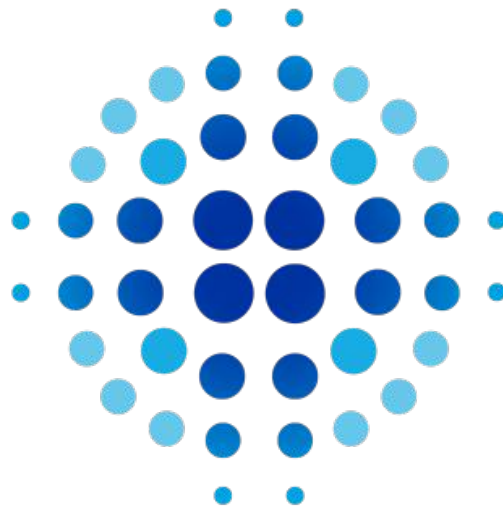


SUNDAY KIDS' ACTIVITIES

You might not be able to print things off at home, so if that's you, some of the pages you'll be able to do in a notebook, blank paper or as a word doc.

Things you'll need this week:

- Printed handouts (choose which pages) OR blank notebook with screen to look at OR device.
- General craft supplies: scissors, glue, tape & string or ribbon
- Pens, coloured pencils, textas, blank A4 paper or poster paper
- A bible

THINK

Who is Jesus? Who do you say Jesus is? That's the big question of the day! In John chapter 7 there's a bunch of people who are not quite sure who Jesus is. Is he a good man? Is he a trouble-maker & liar? Does he have evil spirits in him? Is he the King? Who is he? What do you think? Who do you say Jesus is? Draw or write who you think Jesus is in the space below.

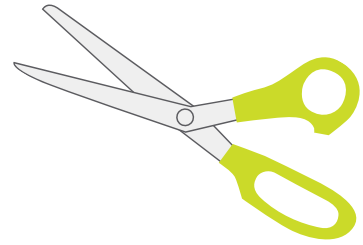


Extra: Read what Jesus says about himself in John 7.
Verse to read: 16-18; 21; 28-29

Questions to help you **THINK**: Who sent Jesus? What does Jesus do and why? What authority does he have?

DRAW: Now that you've thought about the things Jesus says about himself, who do you say he is? How would you add or change what you've written or drawn in your picture above? (You might like to draw a new one of Jesus... don't forget to show us on social media after!)

Materials:

Thick paper (ideally); scissors; tape or glue or stapler; string or ribbon or an alternative.

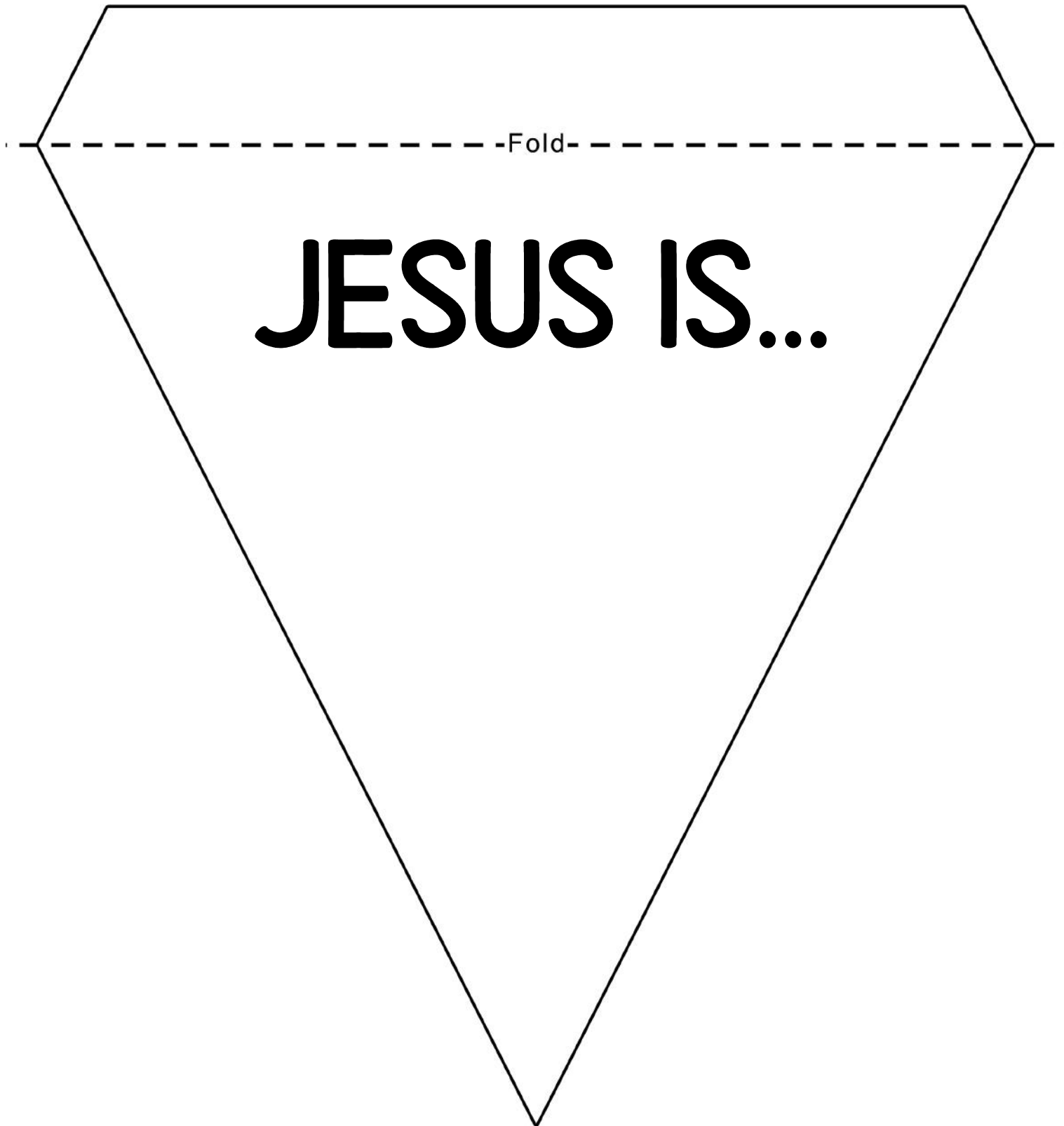
To make the banner:

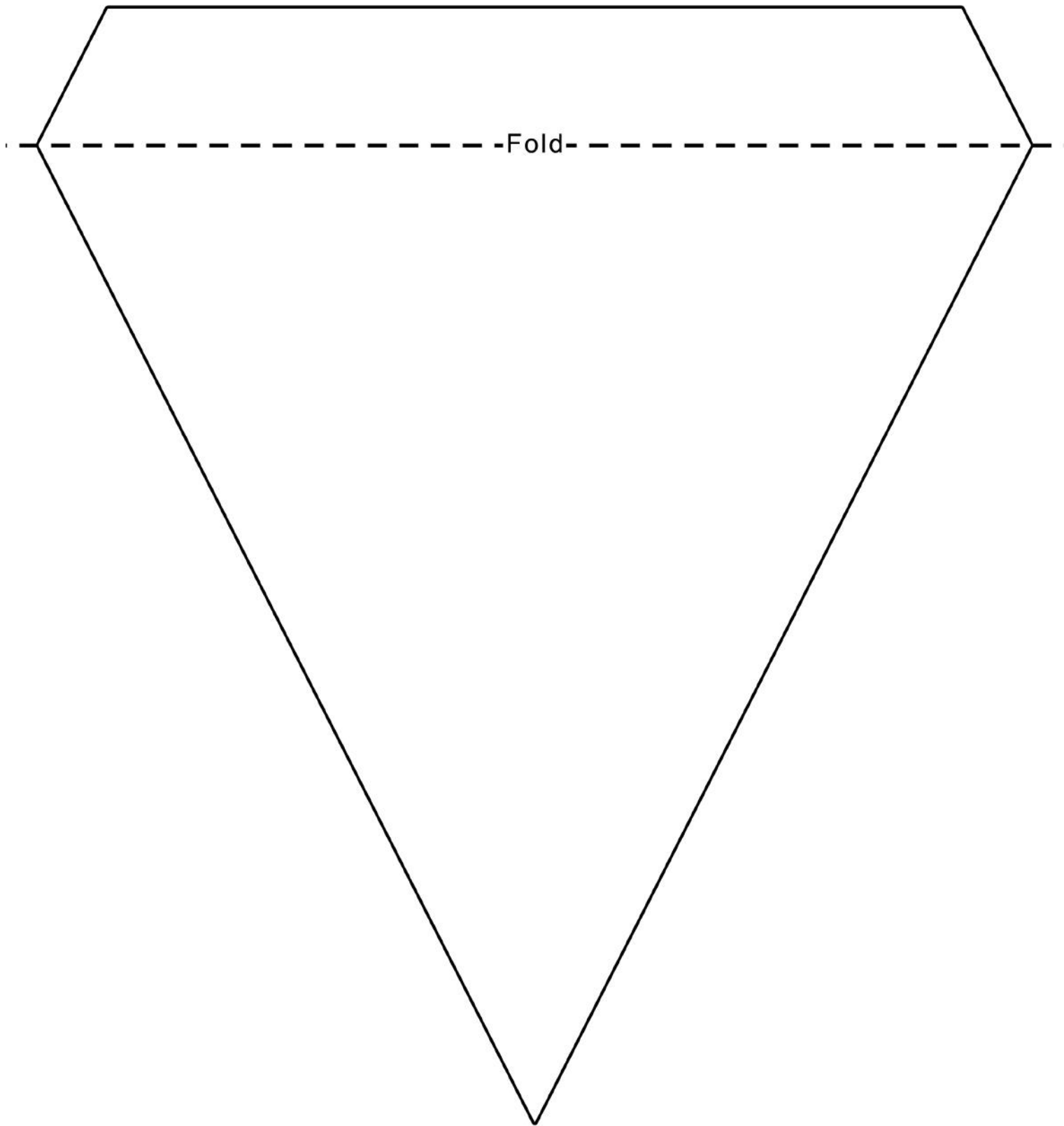
1. Print them out (cardstock will be best). This is a double-sided printable, so you'll want to print it duplex with the fold on the long side. On one side there is a bible verse and the other side a little family devotion idea / teaching point.
2. Use scissors to cut around each piece.
3. Fold each piece along the dotted line.
4. Make sure the pieces are in the correct numbered order before starting the next bit.
5. Place string, ribbon or wool in the fold and glue or staple the banner piece closed.
6. Do this for each piece.
7. Hang your banner in your home and look at one each day & talk about it with your kids.

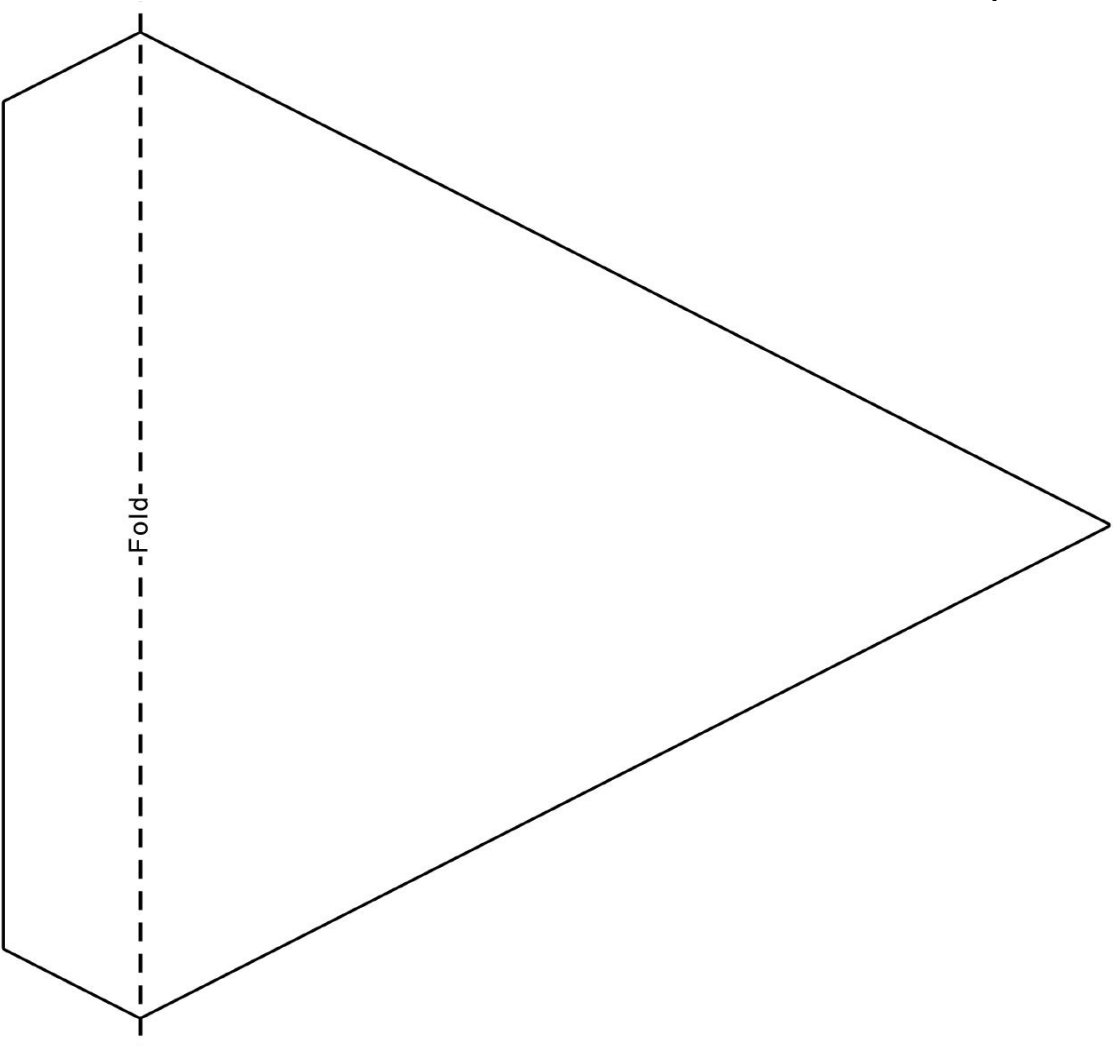
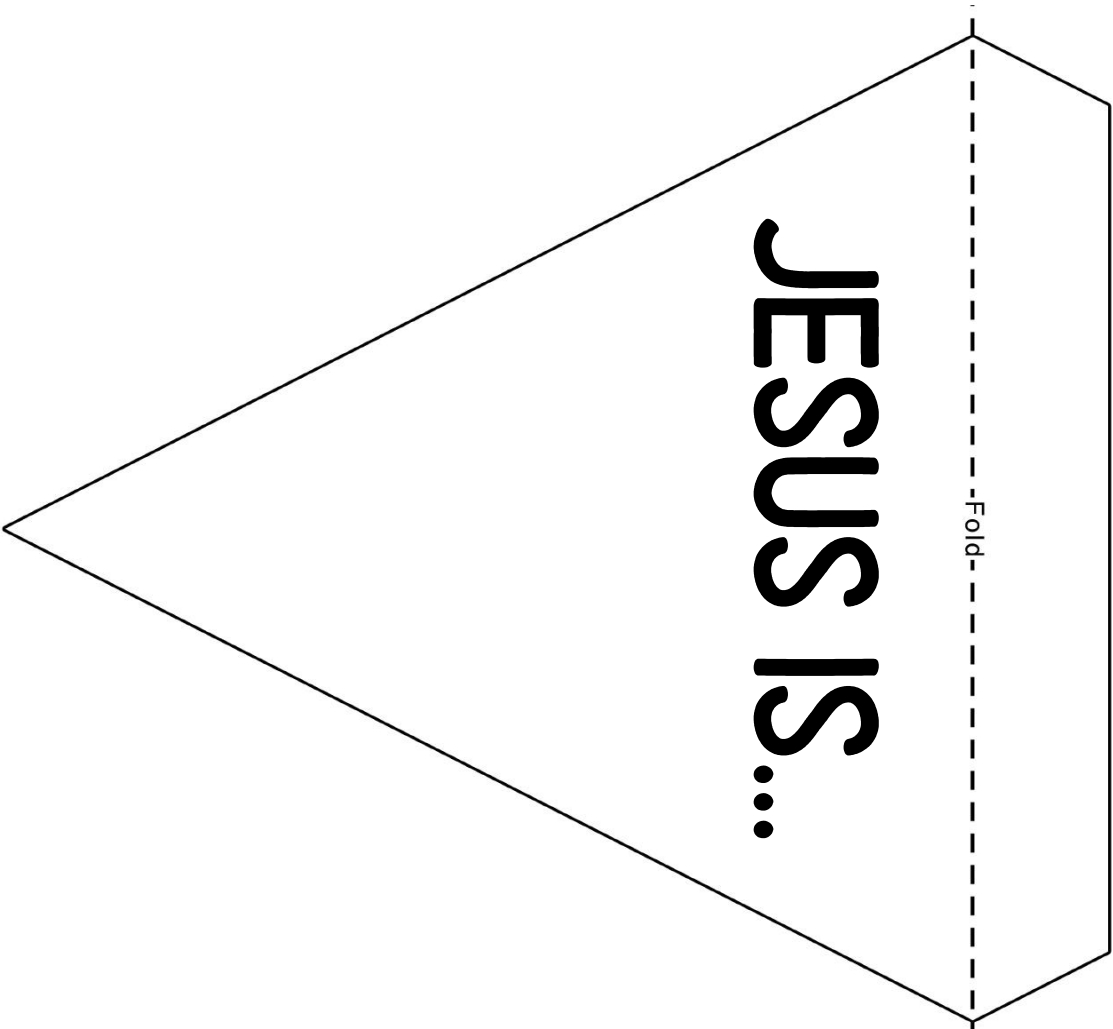
ALTERNATIVE BANNER

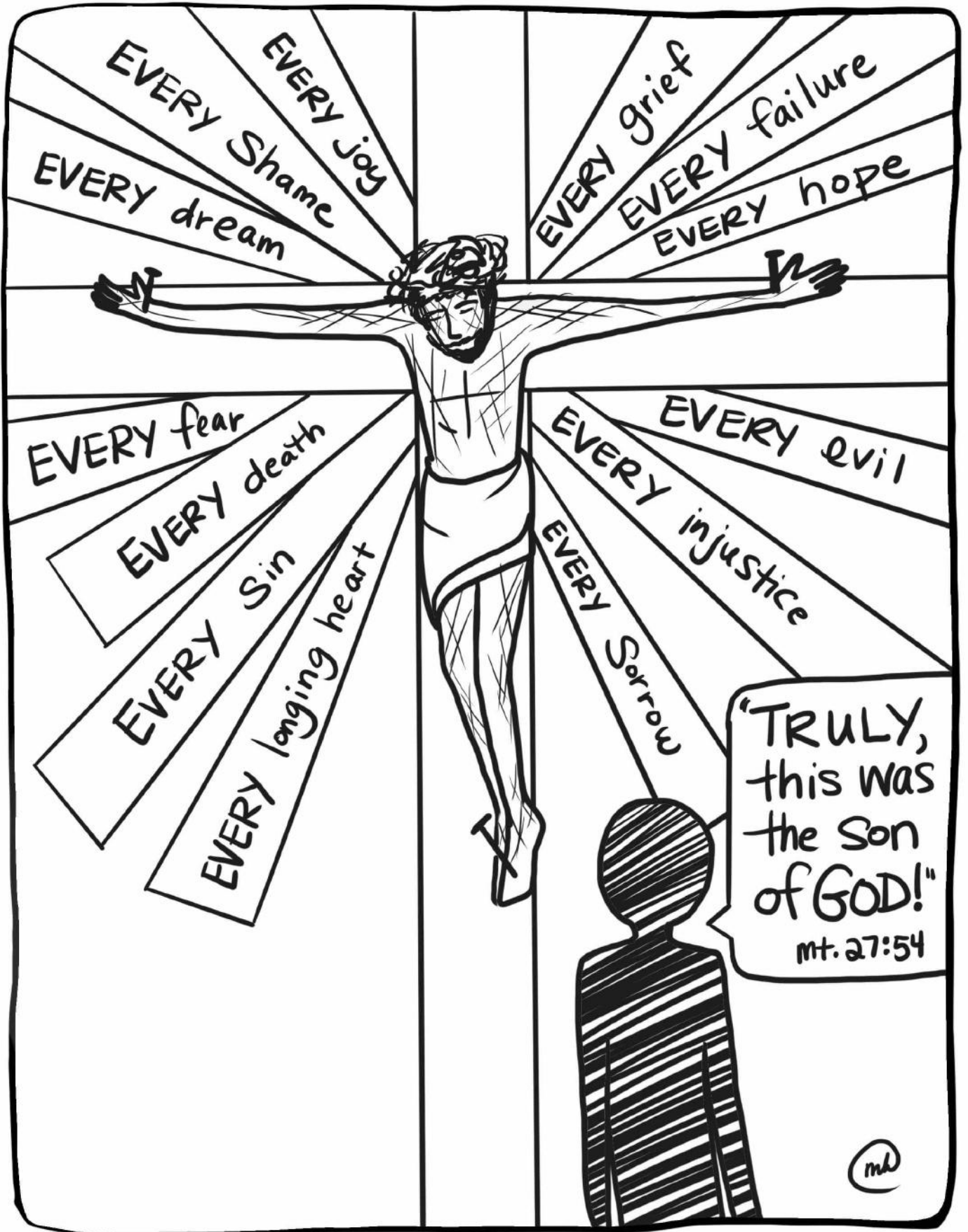

You'll still need: paper, coloured pencils or textas, scissors, tape or glue or stapler, & string or an alternative.



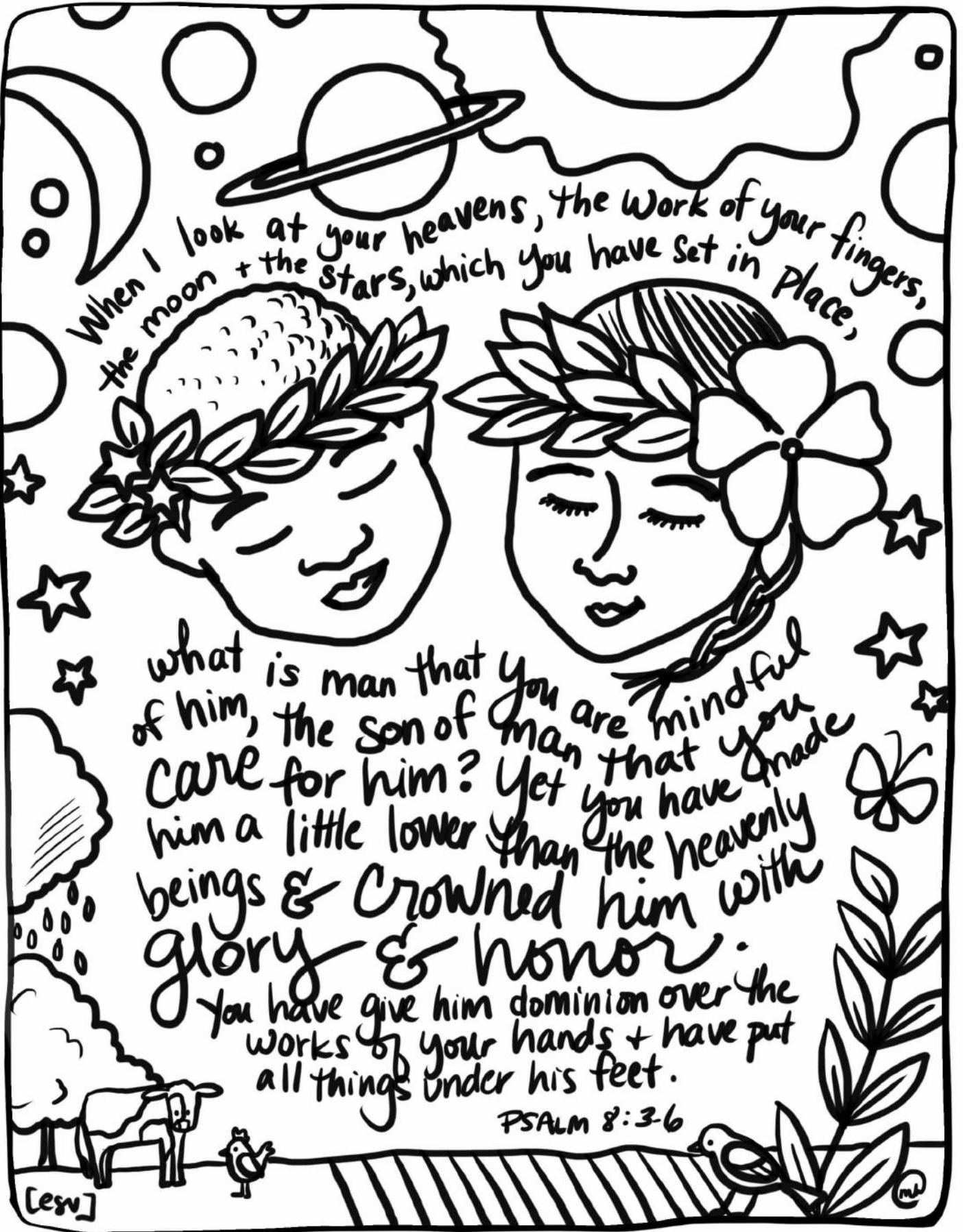
