This commemorated soldier was probably Bert Clarke. He was wounded in action in France in 1916 and lost an eye. He was invalided back to Australia per NZHS *Marama*. His 1917 War Pension statement lists his next-of kin as his new wife, Kathleen Clarke (née Berne), of 251 Nicholson Street, Carlton.
