

## COGHLAN, C. R.

Charles Robert Coghlan was living with his widowed mother at 85 Neill Street, Carlton when he enlisted in 1917. Subsequently his records were updated to reflect his marriage to Charlotte Sophie Joyner in 1918. His unit was sent overseas in March that year: he was wounded in action in September in France and returned to Australia in March 1919.

The World War I Honour Board at Lee Street State School No 1252, North Carlton, shows a C Coghlan which could be Charles Robert Coghlan.
