

DALY, D. B.

Dudley Bernard Daly, born in Richmond in 1890, was the second son of Arthur and Isabella Daly. He married Charlotte Grace Livingstone in 1911 and subsequently moved to Sydney. He enlisted in NSW, registering his wife as his next-of-kin.

His two younger brothers, Denis Roy Daly and Eric Hornabrook Daly, enlisted in Melbourne, nominating their father Arthur of 25 Lytton Street, Carlton, as their next-of-kin. The attached letter from Arthur Daly, dated 1918, asking for information about his son, Dudley, clearly shows the Carlton connection. The three men are listed on the St Jude's Honour Roll.
