

DAWE, F. G.

Frederick Graham Dawe was born in Carlton in 1881 to George and Martha (née Smith) Dawe. His older brother, George Henry Dawe, also born in Carlton, had enlisted the previous year.

The Dawe family lived in Lytton Street, over the road from the Melbourne General Cemetery and next door to the Daly family whose three sons also enlisted. Further along were the Harris, Knowles and Jago families whose men had also enlisted.
