Roy Clarence Cecil Elliott was the younger brother of Plunkett Noble Elliott, who is also listed on the St Jude's Honour Roll. He was born in 1898 to John Plunkett Elliott, a policeman, and Ellen Thompson. Their two older sisters were born in 1890 and 1892.

Roy finished his apprenticeship as a motor mechanic before enlisting in early 1916.

In 1920, on his return from the war, he married Ruby Wright and a daughter was born the following year.
