

GOOD, J. B.

John Brenton Good was the eldest son of Rev John Good, Vicar of St Jude's, and Madeline Blanche Blackham. He was born in 1897 in Essendon. His sisters were Eileen Mary Florence, born 1893, and Moira Bird, born 1895. His younger brother Trevor Blackman was born in 1905. His father was the vicar at St Jude's 1902-1928 and the family grew up at the vicarage at 221 Drummond Street, Carlton.

Brenton, as he was known, was 18 years old and a student when he enlisted. He returned to Australia in 1919. He married a Carlton girl, Ida Ruth Collie, at St Jude's in December 1926 and the couple settled in Preston with Brenton working in the insurance industry. He died in 1985.
