

## GOODWIN, T.

Thomas Charles Goodwin was born in Carlton in 1899 to Thomas and Sarah (née Turney) Goodwin. He was the third son in a large family of nine children.

Thomas served in the Senior Cadets at Carlton before enlisting in May 1918. He returned to Australia in January 1920 on board *Cape Verde*, the last troop ship to bring back AIF servicemen to Australia and was discharged on 20 March 1920.
