

## GRAY, R. G.

Our research suggests that this soldier may have been Robert Gray, a pastrycook who enlisted in August 1915. His wife Rebie moved house several times during the war, but at one stage she lived at 32 David Street, Carlton.

A direct link with St Jude's, Carlton has not been established.
