

JONES, G. R.

George Rupert Charles Clarence Jones was born in 1899 in Carlton to Richard William and Margaret (née Johnson) Jones. His service record noted that his parents were both deceased and that he was living with his guardian, Mrs Mary J Jamieson at 588 Lygon Street, Carlton. His sister, Miss E Jones, was living in David Street, Carlton. His older brother Arthur Albert Jones is also listed on the St Jude's Honour Roll. He had enlisted a year earlier.

George also served in the 2nd AIF, enlisting in 1939. He died in the Heidelberg Repatriation Hospital in 1948.
