

MARSHALL, P. H.

Percy Harold Marshall was born in 1893 in Richmond to Sidney Marshall (1854-1937) and wife Isabella Megson (1857-1938). He was one of the youngest of some nine children: his older brother Albert enlisted in 1914 and is also shown on the St Jude's Honour Roll.

An engineer, Percy enlisted in 1915, giving his father Sidney living at 501 Canning Street, North Carlton as his next-of-kin. He served with 5th Battalion and was sent to Belgium where he was wounded twice.

He returned to Australia in 1919 and later that year married Beatrice Ivy Stevens (1895-1984) and the couple had three children. Percy Marshall died in 1996 at Noble Park.
