

MOONEY, A.

Our research indicates that this soldier was Robert Arthur Mooney (1894-1960) who was born in Northern Ireland and migrated to Australia in 1912 with his brother William (1893-1965). They joined their older brother Samuel Mooney (1889-1967) who had come out to Australia earlier and who was living at 18 Andrew Street, Northcote. Their parents Elizabeth and William Mooney immigrated in 1921 together with their youngest son, Hamilton, and they also settled in Northcote.

A link with St Jude's has not been yet established but Robert's brother William was living in Carlton when he enlisted in 1915.
