

MORRISON, C. S.

Charles Stephen Morrison was born in Carlton in about 1883 to Alfred Alexander and Caroline (née McGuire) Morrison. He had two sisters and a brother, and the family moved between several addresses in Carlton before settling at 66 Neill Street.

On his return from France in 1919, Charles married Mabel Ellen Gaylard (1892-1973) at St Jude's Church. Mabel came from Minyip in the Wimmera. The newly married couple lived with Charles' parents in Neill Street and had one daughter, Lillian Jean, born 1920. Sadly the marriage did not last, and Mabel and Lillian went to live with her sister. Mabel was finally granted a divorce in 1938. Charles died in 1948.
