

MOUNSEY, E. T.

When Edwin Teddie Mounsey enlisted at Welshpool in Gippsland in 1917, he reported that he had been born in Carlton, and he recorded a Carlton friend, Jack Dewan of Elgin Street, as his next of kin. The 1913 Electoral Roll recorded that he was working as a grocer in Welshpool. A connection with St Jude's is not immediately obvious.

Edwin served in France and was wounded in action. He returned to Australia and resettled in Welshpool, marrying Lucy Jane Lindsay in 1924. The couple had one son, Keith. Edwin T Mounsey died in Yarram Hospital in 1952.
