

## PENRICE, F. W.

Frederick William Price was born in Carlton in about 1872 to John Penrice (1835-1926) and Caroline Davis (1840-1907). The couple had at least seven children and lived at 9 Pitt Street for many years, John working as a cabinetmaker.

An orchard labourer, Frederick enlisted in 1916, and served in France. He returned to Australia in 1918. He lived in Lilydale, working again as an orchard hand. He died unexpectedly in 1925 at Killara and is buried in the Lilydale Cemetery.
