

SALLOWS, E. H.

Edward Henry Sallows was born in Carlton in 1891 to Thomas Henry Nicholas Sallows (1859-1930) and Sarah Frances Walbourne (1863-1948). He was the second of six surviving children. The 1903 Electoral Roll lists the family living at 3 Pitt Street, Carlton.

Edward enlisted in 1916 and served in France. He returned to Australia in 1919. Edward married Violet Isabella Rees (1907-1983) in 1938 and the couple had three children. He died at Heidelberg in 1967.

His two younger brothers, Tasman and Alfred, also served in the AIF and are listed on the St Jude's Honour Roll.
