## STOCK, J.

Our research indicates that this soldier was James Albert Stock who was born in 1886 in McDonalds Creek, Mudgee, NSW to Alexander Stock (1856-1914) and Mary Anne Dempsy (1855-1913). The 1912 Electoral Roll records that James and his younger sister Alice were living with their parents at 197 Drummond Street, Carlton.

James Stock enlisted in 1915, giving his next-of-kin as Miss W Heller. (She was the daughter of German migrants who had settled in Brunswick in the 1850s.) The relationship must have been serious for soon after his return from service with the Light Horse in North Africa, James and Winifred Heller (1885-1964) were married. Their son James Louis was born in 1923. James died in 1973 in Pascoe Vale.
