

## WATERS, R.

Reginald Rutherford Waters was born in Carlton in 1895 to Robert Edward Waters and Letitia Hannah Bridges, the seventh of eight children. He grew up as the youngest after little brother Cecil died as an infant.

He enlisted early in 1915. After six months overseas, Reginald died of wounds received in action on the Gallipoli Peninsula on 30 November 1915.

One of his brothers, Louis Henry, is also listed on the St Jude's Honour Roll.

**Description**

Studio portrait of 870 Private (Pte) Reginald Rutherford Waters, 23rd Battalion, of Carlton, Vic. Pte Waters enlisted on 1 March 1915 and embarked from Melbourne aboard HMAT *Euripides* on 8 May 1915.

On 30 November 1915 he died of wounds received at Lone Pine, Gallipoli Peninsula, Turkey.
